In 1969, a group of Mexican American muralists — Frank Romero, Carlos Alvarez, Roberto de la Rocha, Gilbert Lujan — formed the art collective **Los Four** in Los Angeles.

College educated and passionately convicted to their beliefs, **Los Four** was instrumental in introducing Chicano art to the mainstream in the 70s and 80s. Since then, their continued dedication has ushered in new eras of Mexican-American artists with the same values and commitment to the Chicano community.

Today, Gregorio Escalante, gallerist and founder of Juxtapoz magazine (with Zach de la Rocha of *Rage Against the Machine*,) and Chris Zertuche of La Bodega Gallery in Barrio Logan are championing a new movement, **LOS FOUR MEETS LOS 40**.

Led by Abel Alejandre, Mexican-born, L.A.-based hyperrealist artist, and

Joshua Ben Paskowitz, artist and youngest member of the Paskowitz surf family, **Los 40** is a collective of forty contemporary Chicano-influenced artists paving extraordinary independent paths while honoring the pioneering spirit and message of the original crew.

A group exhibition running April 1-11, 2017 at La Bodega Gallery, **LOS FOUR MEETS LOS 40** "will carry the torch into the future as we renew our commitment to our cultural legacy of richness and diversity," said Zertuche of La Bodega Gallery.
